Collaboration agreement: Crossborder Journalism Campus (CJC)

The students of INSERT NAME OF THE UNIVERSITY (hereafter the team members) understand and agree that any data set which was provided to the Crossborder Journalism Campus (CJC) project and shared with its project team members, and any work product or analyses provided to the team members will not be shared with or copied to any third party outside the CJC project - unless and until the CJC project lead has given permission in written form. The same terms are binding on other CJC project team members in respect of any work product or analyses any of the team members provide.

The team members agree that the CJC will be prominently and fully credited with the story in any publication, broadcast or other medium of communication - and in subsequent prize entries based upon the CJC project. In television, radio and podcast stories the CJC must be mentioned early in the narrative and credited again in the end credits.

The team members understand and agree that the project is mutually eo-operative and that all team members are required to share work products and analyses. We expect everyone to communicate well, often and respectfully. The team members agree to inform CJC team members promptly about any significant findings within data sets or information provided by sources.

The team members understand that anybody they bring in to work on this project would be subject to this agreement, and would be bound to the same terms and answerable to the CJC project leaders.

The team members agree to inform CJC of their involvement in any parallel project that could pose a conflict of interest with the CJC project. The team members agree that CJC may exclude them from the project if the conflict of interest can't be resolved on mutually agreeable terms. Upon any such termination, the team members may not use any information learned or materials obtained solely through this project membership in connection with the parallel project or otherwise and will immediately return all such materials to CJC.

CJC agrees that what stories you decide to publish will remain within your editorial control and the onus remains on you to get the facts right and to ensure that all the correct legal processes are followed.
